Reducing Emissions with Innovative Truck Reservation Systems

Our industry-leading truck reservation systems remove 32,500 tonnes of CO2 from the air annually by decreasing idling time – the equivalent of taking 6,900 cars off the road. The system also helps reduce local congestion and noise and light pollution.

GCT Bayonne Wetlands Protection

During the recent expansion project at GCT Bayonne, we created new tidal wetlands and preserved 6.5 hectares (16 acres) of adjacent land along the Hackensack River.

Shore Power

The introduction of shore power at GCT Deltaport not only eliminates up to ninety-five tonnes of air pollutants per year per vessel, it also reduces wear and tear on ships, resulting in less downtime. Vessels using shore power at GCT Deltaport also qualify for special harbor rates through the EcoAction program.

Safer Work Environments

The introduction of semi-automated machinery, remote operations centers, and redesigned traffic flows at GCT Bayonne and GCT Deltaport have created a safer environment for our workforce and supply chain partners by reducing human and machine interactions.

Decoupling Emissions Growth from Volume Handled

As the largest tenant of the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority, GCT Canada has reduced their absolute emissions by 10% compared to the 2014 baseline year, proving that it is possible to decouple business growth from emissions growth.
