

## GCT Future of Nations Scholarship for Indigenous Students Tsawwassen First Nation 2025

**About**: The GCT Future of Nations Scholarship for Indigenous Students program annually awards scholarships to members of Indigenous Nations whose treaty and traditional territories intersect with GCT operations.

This specific scholarship will award one (1) scholarship per year valued at \$2,500.00 to a Tsawwassen First Nation Member student who demonstrates strong academic performance, community involvement, and leadership. GCT introduced its first annual Scholarship with TFN in 2022.

**Deadline:** The 2025 scholarship launched on May 16, 2025. Applications must be submitted by 5:00PM on August 8, 2025.

## **Eligibility:**

- Tsawwassen First Nation Member
- Permanent resident or citizen of Canada
- Applied to or are currently enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution (Industry Training Authority training program, trades or technical school, college, or university)
- Maintain a course load that leads to a recognized degree, certificate, designation, or diploma
- Has not received a scholarship from GCT in the past two years
- All programs and pursuits of study are eligible and applications from all are encouraged

**Requirements:** Ensure the following documents are included with your application submission.

- Completed application form (as enclosed)
- One (1) reference telephone number
- Official transcript of grades (high school and/or most recently available post-secondary)
- Resume, including volunteer experience
